

Compliance with HB 3693

Childress County Appraisal District will comply with the requirements of HB 3693 (Government Code 2264.001(b)) by compiling and posting the following information as soon as practicable after January 1, 2018:

- 1) The total metered amount of electricity, water, and natural gas used by the District for its services in 2017. The annual metered amounts can be separately listed for each utility service without violating confidentiality terms.
- 2) The total amount paid for electricity, water and natural gas in 2017. The total annual cost paid for the three utility services are posted as one figure.

Appraisal District Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2016

The Childress County Appraisal District purchase natural gas from Atmos Energy. In calendar year 2017, the District purchased a total of 891 hundred cubic feet of natural gas.

The District purchased electricity from TriEagle Energy. In calendar year 2017, the District purchased a total of 21,125 kilowatt hours.

The District purchases water from the City of Childress Water Department. In calendar year 2017, the District used a total of 8,341 gallons of water but paid on the monthly minimum of 5,000.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the District in the calendar year 2017 is \$5174.68.
